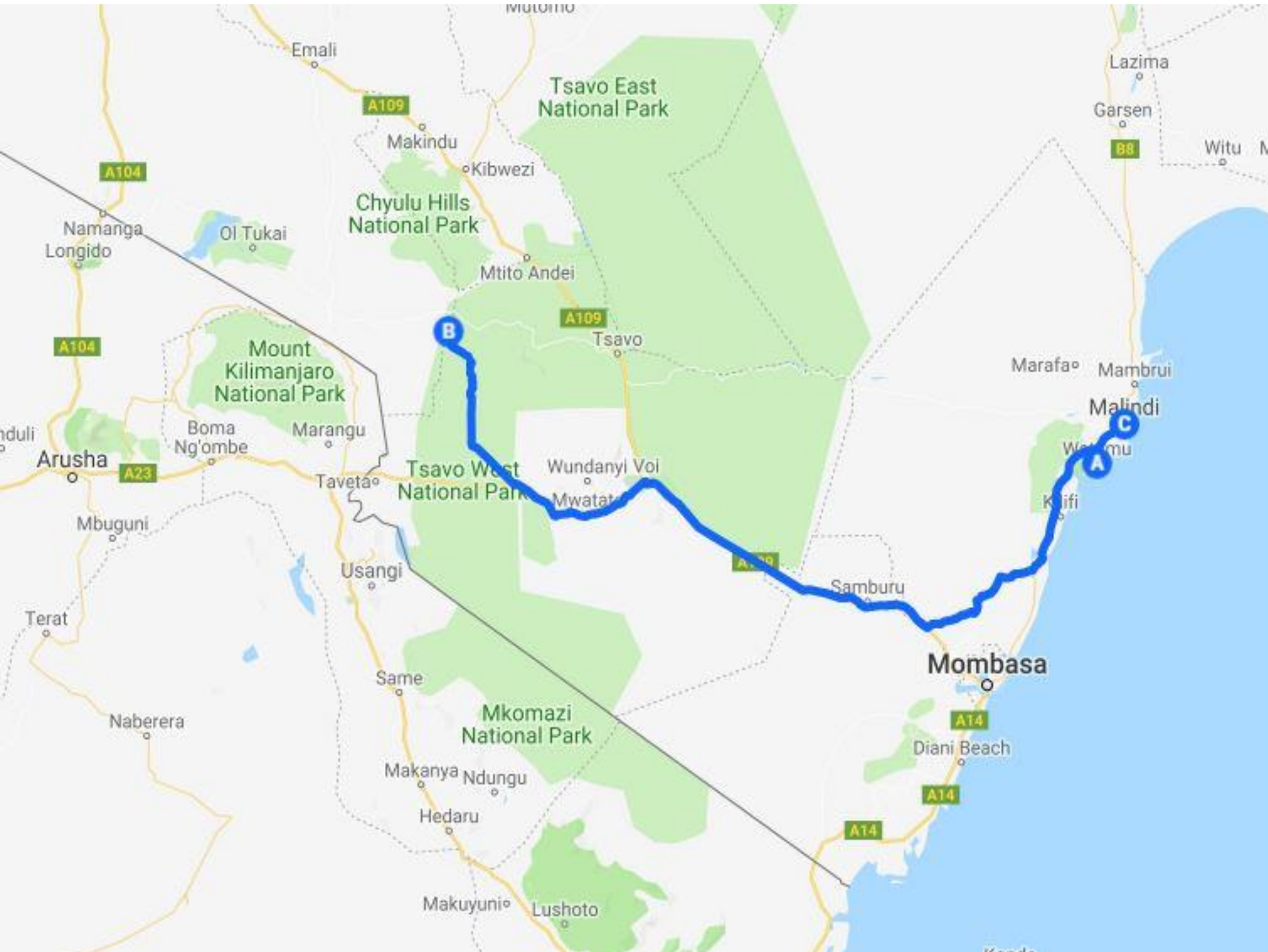

Located in the Tsavo West National Park, Finch Hattons Luxury Camp is set around natural fresh water springs within 9,065 square kilometres of pure untouched wilderness, surrounded by views of Mount Kilimanjaro and the magnificent Chyulu Hills.

"Denys Finch Hatton was a legendary British aristocrat who travelled to Kenya in 1911 and fell under the spell of the African wild. His fascination with the wildlife turned him into a renowned photographer, dedicated conservationist and host, introducing both business tycoons and British Royalty to his world of Luxury Safari."

1 Day

H. 06.00 Departure from the Coast in direction of Tsavo West National Park.

Traveling along the "Mariakani" road that passes through typical African villages and a splendid palm grove. On the way we will stop for a coffee.

H. 13.00 Arrival at Finch Hattons Camp – Accommodation and Lunch

Tsavo West National Park is full of enchanting landscapes and lush vegetation, crossed by the ancient lava flows of the Shetani Volcano.

H. 16.00 Game drive until sunset

H. 18.30 Back to the Camp

H. 20.00 Dinner and overnight





TSAVO WEST NATIONAL PARK

“Land of Lava, Springs, Man-Eaters & Magical Sunsets”

The park covers an area of 9,065 square kilometres. The A109 road Nairobi-Mombasa and a railway divides it from the adjoining Tsavo East National Park.

From the sight of fifty million gallons of crystal-clear water gushing out of from the under parched lava rock that is the Mzima Springs to the Shetani lava flows, Tsavo West is a beautiful, rugged wilderness.

The savannah ecosystem comprises of open grasslands, scrublands, and Acacia woodlands, belts of riverine vegetation and rocky ridges including the Poacher's Lookout where visitors can see the teeming herds in the plains below.

Tsavo West offers some of the most magnificent game viewing in the world and attractions include elephant, rhino, Hippos, lions, cheetah, leopards, Buffalos, diverse plant and bird species including the threatened corncrake and near threatened Basra Reed Warbler.

H. 07.00 Game drive and visit the natural spring of "Mzima Springs"

MZIMA SPRINGS

Mzima Springs are a series of four natural springs in Tsavo National Park, Kenya. They are located in the west of the Park, around 48 km from Mtito Andei.

The source of the springs is a natural reservoir under the Chyulu Hills to the north. The Chyulu range is composed of volcanic lava rock and ash, which is too porous to allow rivers to flow.

Instead, rain water percolates through the rock, and may spend 25 years underground before emerging 50 kilometres away at Mzima.

The natural filtration process gives rise to Mzima's famously clear stream, which flows through a series of pools and rapids.

Two kilometres downstream from the springs, the stream is blocked by a solidified flow and disappears below the surface again. Mzima is one of the most famous natural attractions of Tsavo West thanks to the hippos and crocodiles of the Nile that live here in the spring pools.
